



## CFL ONE WAY SYSTEMS

- 1. CAR PARK:** the car park will operate under the normal one way system, as will the overflow car park.
- 2. ENTRANCE TO THE FALLS:** we have moved the entrance to the Falls from the old Reception to an open air entrance Kiosk to the right of the old Reception and accessible from the Car Park road. The new Reception will operate from the Kiosk. Temporary fencing and signage has been put in place to guide visitors into the Falls. Perspex sneeze guards are in place. Tickets must now be booked on a timed entry basis via the CFL website and the business now operates on a 'card only' basis.
- 3. THE WALK:** this is already one way.
- 4. PLATFORM AT THE TOP OF THE FALLS:** Visitors are asked to observe social distancing guidelines and to limit themselves to two families at any one time on the platform. Leaflets will be handed to visitors on entry explaining this and there will be extra signage at the top of the Falls as well as on-site COVID marshalls when deemed necessary at busy times.
- 5. SNACK BAR:** Visitors are asked to queue in such a way as to enable appropriate social distancing between one another.
- 6. CAFÉ:** The café will offer a limited offering of pre-packed sandwiches and other snacks. This should enable the queue to pass through quickly. A one way system is in place with the entrance at the double doors next to the Boat Club shed and the exit onto the terrace and down the steps towards Swan Lake. There will be no indoor seating but the outdoor seating, appropriately distanced, will be available for visitors to use.
- 7. TOILETS:** there will be a one way system with the entrance via the path leading to the Disabled Toilet and the exit down the steps to the Snack Bar courtyard. Appropriate signage etc will be put in place.
- 8. SHOP/EXIT:** The old Reception will now be EXIT ONLY and No Entry signage has been placed appropriately at the top of the tarmac ramp leading down to it. Visitors will be asked to social distance within the shop and then exit via either of the doors and up the tarmac ramp back to the car park.
